

How to get to the tournament



Venue

Main competition:

Venue for semifinals and finals:

Rector's office, Brno University of Technology, Antonínská 1, 602 00 Brno

Car

You can arrive directly to the fencing venue. Parking is available on the street, but there are parking zones. The good news is that during weekend the parking zones are for free.

Public transport

From Prague:

The fastest way by public transport is to take a bus from *Bus Station Florenc* (Flixbus costs about 10 eur, 2,5 h drive). Taking a train is another option, more comfortable but slower and little bit more expensive (about 3h and 15 eur). You can take train from the Main Train Station (*Hlavní Nádraží*).

Other cities:

The same principle applies to travelling from other big cities, the best option seems to be travelling by bus.

Abou the Brno University of Technology


The Brno University of
Technology (BUT) was
founded on September 19,
1899, by Emperor Franz
Joseph I of Hungary. It's the
first Czech university in
Moravia and has grown to be
internationally recognized.

With eight faculties and three institutes, BUT offers education in engineering, science, economics, and the arts. It emphasizes research and development, operating five research centers and collaborating on two centers of excellence with other institutions.

Brno

The organising city **Brno**, is the second largest city in the Czech Republic. Brno is the seat of the South **Moravian Region**. The city has a total area of 230.18 km² and has approx. 379,000 inhabitants, with about 700,000 inhabitants living in its metropolitan area. The Svratka and Svitava rivers flow through Brno and converge in the southern part of the city.



In the 19th century, thanks to its well-developed textile industry, Brno was nicknamed "Austrian Manchester".

Now, in the 21st century, thanks to the development of information technology hub, it is referred to as "Czech Silicon Valley."

Today, the city is an important center of education with **10 universities** with 29 faculties with almost 65,000 students. The formerly dominant engineering plants in the city include Zbrojovka (means "Armory") and tractor manufacturer Zetor.
